

# SCC Agenda Minutes from November 19, 2015

1. We still need to review and adopt minutes from the September meeting. We were short on attendees at the November meeting so we were unable to approve them at the meeting. We will do this via email with each member of the council.
2. We went over the 2014-2015 Land Trust Final report. Money from the Land Trust was used to hire assistants to allow teacher time to collaborate on student data, plan Tier 1, 2 and 3 instruction, monitor student progress and support Tier 2 interventions.

Westvale also purchased a site license for Brain Pop.

Substitutes were provided so that teacher could attend professional development conferences on Math and Language Arts.

Teachers were provided inservice pay to attend CHAMPS, behavior management classes.

A computer lab assistant was hired to work with students in providing grade level core computer skills and keyboarding practice.

With the remaining funds, the goal is to hire a certified teacher that would be able to help in the classrooms allowing the teachers to take advantage of a 90 minute collaboration after school and to make up for lost preparation time.

There is also a goal to hire a P.E. Specialist for the school.

3. We discussed families in the community in need. There were some available funds to help families who might need help during the Christmas season. Anyone with information about a family who might fall into this categories was to pass along the information to Mrs. Christensen.
