## Level 1 Behaviors

Handled by teacher

### **Be a Positive Leader**

- Exclusion
- Spreading or starting rumors

### **Always Safe**

- Touching other students
- Minor inappropriate physical contact
- Throwing paper
- Minor mistreating property
- Running in the halls

### **Be Caring & Responsible**

- Off task
- Disruptive behavior in the bathrooms
- Bringing toys to school
- Eating food, candy or drinks in class or playground
- Coming in late from recess
- Unprepared
- Misuse of supplies
- Minor misuse of technology

### **Be Kind & Respectful**

- Teasing other students
- Arguing
- Talking out
- Lying
- Mistreating property
- Name calling
- Taking someone's things without asking
- Yelling

## Level 2 Behaviors

Handled by teacher  
(Documented as a Minor Incident in Ed. Handbook)

### **Be a Positive Leader**

- Physical or verbal threats

### **Always Safe**

- Participating in inappropriate contact (tackling, pushing, tripping, play fighting, soft biting, pinching)
- Spitting/inappropriate contact of any sort
- Throwing rocks/snowballs
- Play fighting

### **Be Caring & Responsible**

- Cheating
- Use of wheels on school property
- Using technology inappropriately

### **Be Kind & Respectful**

- Direct defiance towards an adult
- Swearing (Offensive Language)
- Backbiting, name calling, gossip
- Cheating
- Severe lying

### **Chronic Level Behaviors**

Demonstrating chronic minor misbehavior more than 3 times per week.

## Level 3 Behaviors

Refer to Administration  
(Documented as Office Referral in Ed. Handbook)

- Bullying
- Biting (Hard Biting - Bleeding)
- Self harm
- Sexual harassment
- Racial harassment
- Serious physical or verbal threats
- Bringing weapons, using items as weapons
- Bringing or using illegal substances
- Vandalizing
- Showing severe defiance or assaulting adults
- Using obscenities direct at teacher
- Stealing
- Fighting (causes bodily harm to another student - Blood)

### **Chronic Level 2 Behaviors**

Demonstrating chronic minor misbehavior more than 3 times per week.
